## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

There are 3 tracts in the conference:

### TRACT A :

**Live-streaming** that can be watched at the same time for physical ('on-site') and virtual ('online') participants. Plenary lectures by international speakers will be pre-recorded and played back during their respective sessions. Participants can ask questions/submit comments either physically (for on-site participants and to local speakers) or via Slido (for on-site and online participants). Slido questions/comments for overseas speakers will be collated and sent to respective speakers for response. Received replies will be uploaded onto the website.

### TRACTS B & C :

Concurrent to tract A, **on-site participants** can attend sessions in tracts B and C, and they can ask questions/offer comments directly. Online participants can ask questions/submit comments later via Slido which will be forwarded to the speaker/panel for response. Received replies will be uploaded onto the website. Sessions in tracts B and C will be uploaded onto the website to be **viewed both by on-site as well as online participants**: Morning sessions are planned to be uploaded by 6pm and evening sessions by 12 midnight on the same day.
